- The completed East Frederick Survey District Maryland Inventory of Historic Properties (MIHP) Form was discussed.
- There was consensus that the Schleysville Historic District (part of East Frederick Survey District) is the stronger of the two historic districts recommended.
- There was consensus that outreach efforts to the property owners within the East Frederick Survey District, and particularly to those in the Schleysville Historic District, is needed before any recommendations regarding designation applications are made to the Historic Preservation Commission.
- Staff will look into possible dates for an informational meeting for property owners.
- Other efforts to acknowledge the historic of East Frederick Survey District and/or Schleysville Historic District could include a roadside marker.
- The remaining individual resources from the Comprehensive Plan list within NAC 12 were discussed. (Airport Terminal, Fairview Cemetery)
- Other individual resources from the Comprehensive Plan list were discussed. (Maryland State Odd Fellows Home, Linden Grove). The current lessee of the Odd Fellows Home previously expressed interested in designation and may be considering purchasing the property. Kate McConnell will reach out to their board. Linden Grove may be the subject of a demolition review application in the near future.
