Description: The subject property is located at 94 Worman’s Mill Court and currently zoned Light Industrial. The property is also located within the Highway Noise Overlay. The Applicant is proposing to construct a new 12,700 structure on the currently vacant lot 4 of the Worman’s Mill Industrial Park. The structure will be used for a seafood shop, heating and air conditioning shop, and a professional office. The project will include proposed signage and onsite dumpster. The project is also providing joint parking to include 23 parking spaces and 2 bike spaces.

GUEST SPEAKERS:

- **Tim Davis – Frederick Municipal Airport**
 FDK is an enterprise fund meaning revenue pays for expenses. Staff 73,000 operations in a typical year. They have 2 runways and an air traffic control tower. FDK has two full-time staff people as well as a part time maintenance person and a shared transportation engineer. There are three flight schools located on the property. This is also the location of MSP helicopter Trooper 3. FDK is considered a reliever airport. This is the only public airport in Frederick County. There have been a couple of projects in the works including a longer runway. They have also put up fencing and recently completed a snow removal equipment building. Please follow them on Facebook.

- **Captain Pat Grossman – FPD Headquarters building**

Captain Grossman did a power point presentation showing the deficiencies of the current FPD headquarters. Lack of space has spread employees out over numerous building, which has created inefficiencies throughout the agency.
