FOCUS FOUR CRIMES

Robbery	2019-053073- Officers responded to David Lane Park for the report of a robbery, the Victim stated that she was robbed of a sum of money during a drug transaction. The Victim does not know the male. Case referred to CIS and DEU for follow-up.
Burglary	2019-049391-The Victim advised officers that a known individual entered her house through an unlocked front door. The Suspect confronted the Victim in the residence about the location of their child in common. The child was not on scene and this angered the Suspect. The Suspect took the Victim's phone and left the scene. Charges pending.
Theft of Auto	2019-039333- Victim went out to his truck which was parked on the street in front of his residence. The Victim observed the truck to have a disassembled steering column with apparent damage. Tools were also missing from the truck. The vehicle was left unlocked. No suspect information at this time. 2019-049727- Victim advised that a known individual had possession of their vehicle. Officers contacted the Suspect and advised that the vehicle was in the possession of another individual. The Suspect indicated that a previous agreement between him and the Victim allowed him to use the vehicle as long as he maintained it. Referred for charges.

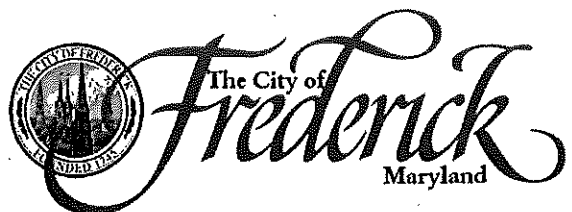

Proposal:

The subject property is located on at 577 Himes Avenue and zoned Professional Business (PB). The property is also located within the Highway Noise Overlay (HNO). Lot 2 is currently not developed and located adjacent to the Dutch's Daughter restaurant. The lot is approximately 5.55 acres. The Application proposes to construct 76 parking spaces to support the operations of the Dutch's Daughter restaurant. There will be approximately 1.14 acres disturbed for the construction of the parking lot. The proposed parking lot will have interior landscaping and will be screened by 19 shade trees and 9 evergreen trees. The parking lot will have a cross access easement with the adjacent property. There are currently eight (8) handicapped accessible parking spaces meeting the requirement in the existing Dutch's Daughter parking lot and none proposed for the overflow parking lot. The Applicant is also proposing bike parking spaces and parking lot lighting.

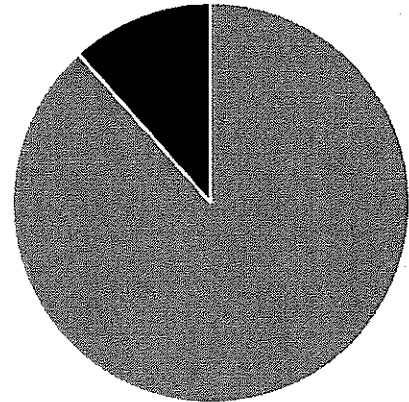
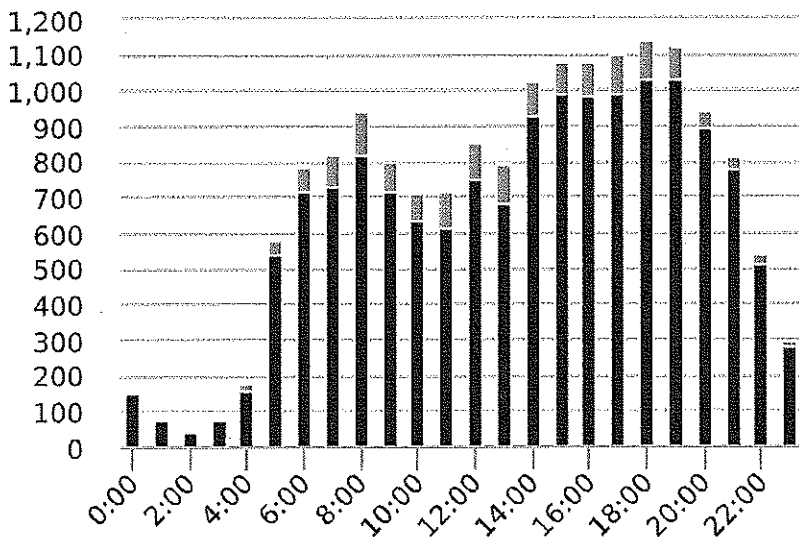

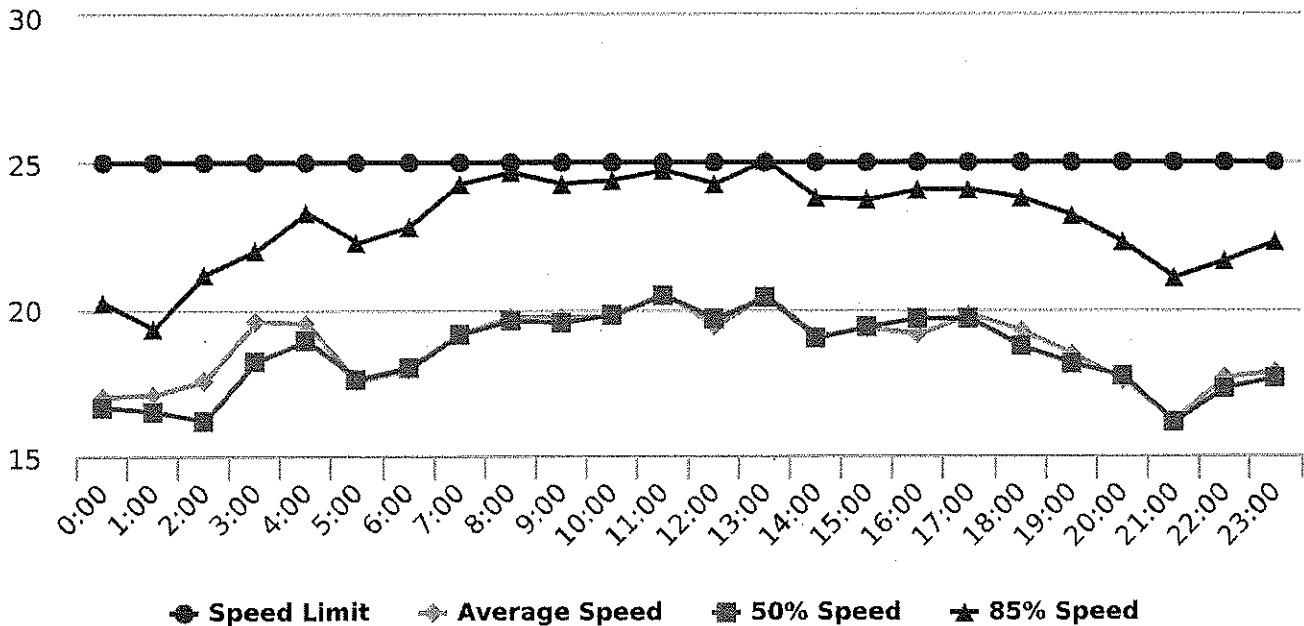
