A RESOLUTION CONCERNING

CommUNITY 2030: A Ten Year Strategic Plan for The City of Frederick

BACKGROUND

The first strategic plan of The City of Frederick, known as CommUNITY 2030 (the "Plan"), has been developed by the Mayor's office with the significant input of the Board of Aldermen, staff, the Mayor's Strategic Opportunities Advisory Team, City residents, and other community stakeholders. The Plan declares the City's mission statement: "The City of Frederick provides responsive, effective, and innovative services that promote and enhance safety, well-being, and success in our community". The Plan captures the overarching ten-year vision of the City and is intended to guide all future planning documents and assist with the budget preparation process. The Plan frames the community's vision of the City ten years from now and describes the goals, objectives, and initiatives needed to achieve that vision. It characterizes and prioritizes the government's role in achieving the vision, and also identifies areas of advocacy and collaboration with others who share in the responsibility of achieving the vision.

After careful consideration and discussion, the Board of Aldermen finds that it is in the best interests of the City of Frederick to adopt certain portions of the Plan, as further described herein.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FREDERICK that the following portions of the document entitled "CommUNITY 2030: A Ten Year Strategic Plan for The City of Frederick", attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by this reference, are hereby adopted. Such portions are: Chapter 2 ("Planning Overview"), Chapter 4 ("Vision, Strategic Goals and Objectives"), and Chapter 5 ("Implementation Process").


