Robbery	<p>19-102458- Attempted armed robbery at Bob Evans. Two subjects believed to be white males entered the Bob Evans with a black handgun. It is believed the males then saw another employee push the panic button and then the males fled the store. (<i>Open investigation</i>)</p> <p>19-103655- Strong armed robbery at Famous Dave's. Female entered the restaurant and was attempting to pay for food. While the cashier was counting money the female reached across the counter and “snatch” the money from the cashier’s hand and placed it in her pocket. The female was located and arrested. (<i>Closed by arrest</i>)</p> <p>19-104310- Strong armed robbery at 1275 W. Patrick St. (Giant Eagle). Subject entered Giant Eagle and approached the service desk. Once at the service desk, the subject passed a note demanding \$100.00. Subject then fled the area. (<i>Open investigation</i>)</p> <p>19-104370- Armed Robbery at 1275 W. Patrick St. (Subway) Subject entered the Subway and insinuated he had a gun in his waste-band. Subject then removed all the money from the register and then fled the store.
