ORDINANCE NO: G-23-01

AN ORDINANCE concerning

The FY 2023 Fee Schedule parking for Fire in Ice

BY Amending Ordinance No. G-22-04

BACKGROUND

On May 19, 2022, the Board of Aldermen enacted Ordinance No. G-22-04, to be effective July 1, 2022, adopting a master schedule of administrative and regulatory fees for Fiscal Year 2023, known as the Fiscal Year 2023 Fee Schedule.

The February First Saturday event organized by the Downtown Frederick Partnership, known as “Fire In Ice”, attracts significant crowds to Downtown Frederick. In order to reduce vehicle traffic downtown and thereby increase the safety of this event, the Partnership is implementing measures to encourage people to void parking downtown. Specifically, to encourage the use of free shuttles that will be provided, one such measure proposed is an increase in the fee to park in City parking decks.

Based on the foregoing, the Board of Aldermen desires to amend the Fiscal Year 2023 Fee Schedule to increase the fee for parking during Fire in Ice from \$6 to \$10. The \$4 difference will be dedicated to paying for the costs of the additional safety measures to be implemented for this event.

SECTION I. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FREDERICK, That:

- (a) That portion of the Fiscal Year 2023 Fee Schedule containing the fees for the Parking Department, specifically “Special Event Parking. . . Fire in Ice Parking Flat Rate” is hereby amended such that the fee will be \$10.00 instead of \$6.00
- (b) Ordinance No. G-22-04 remains in effect as originally enacted and subsequently amended.

SECTION II. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FREDERICK, That nothing herein shall be construed to limit the authority of the Board of Aldermen to adopt additional fees and charges, and that in the event of a conflict between this ordinance and any other ordinance or resolution hereafter adopted, the other ordinance or resolution shall prevail unless otherwise expressly stated therein.

SECTION III. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FREDERICK, That this ordinance shall take effect on the date it is signed by the mayor.

SECTION IV. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FREDERICK, That in the event of a conflict between this ordinance and any other ordinance or resolution previously adopted by The City of Frederick, this ordinance shall prevail.

SECTION V. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FREDERICK, That in the event any provision, section, sentence, clause, or part of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any remaining

provision, section, sentence, clause, or part of this ordinance, it being the intent of the City that such remainder shall be and shall remain in full force and effect.
