

SPECIAL ORDINANCE S-23-01

A SPECIAL ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE BUDGET OF THE CITY OF FREDERICK FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 2022 TO JUNE 30, 2023 TO INCLUDE REVENUE AND EXPENDITURES FOR A GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION GRANT

WHEREAS, by Article VII, §5 of the Charter of The City of Frederick it is provided that the budget shall be prepared and adopted in the form of an ordinance upon a favorable vote of at least a majority of the total membership of the Board of Aldermen; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen did meet in public on May 19, 2022 and did by a majority vote to accept and approve the budget, as submitted by the Mayor to the Board of Aldermen on April 1, 2022, and as amended by memoranda from the Mayor to the Board of Aldermen dated May 13, 2022, and as amended at the meeting of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen on May 19, 2022, and passed by a majority at the meeting of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen on May 19, 2022 as required by Article VII, §5 of the Charter of The City of Frederick; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen did adopt and enact the budget on May 19, 2022, as required by Article VII, §5 of the Charter of The City of Frederick; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen did adopt and enact the budget on May 19, 2022, to take effect on July 1, 2022, by Special Ordinance S-22-08; and

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption and enactment of the budget the City received a grant from the Governor's Office of Crime Control and Prevention for professional development; and

WHEREAS, the General Fund budget, as adopted and enacted by Special Ordinance S-22-08 must be amended to include revenue and professional services expenditures of \$52,500.



NOW, THEREFORE:

SECTION I: BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FREDERICK, that the budget for The City of Frederick for the fiscal year July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023, as submitted by the Mayor to the Board of Aldermen on April 1, 2022, and as amended by memoranda from the Mayor to the Board of Aldermen dated May 13, 2022 and as amended at the meeting of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen on May 19, 2022, and passed by a majority at the meeting of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen on May 19, 2022 as required by Article VII, §5 of the Charter of The City of Frederick and as adopted and enacted on May 19, 2022, by Special Ordinance S-22-08, and effective July 1, 2022, be and the same is hereby amended to include revenue and professional services expenditures of \$52,500.


