

SPECIAL ORDINANCE S-23-07

A SPECIAL ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE TAX RATE FOR THE ASSESSABLE PROPERTY IN THE CITY OF FREDERICK FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 2023 TO JUNE 30, 2024

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article VII, §9 of the Charter of The City of Frederick, the City annually may levy and collect taxes on the assessable property within the City Boundary; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen did meet in public on May 18, 2023, and did by majority impose and levy the proposed sum of Seventy-Three and 5/100 Cents (\$0.7305) on each and every One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) of assessable real property and One Dollar and Fifty-Five Cents (\$1.55) on each and every One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) of assessable business personal property for the fiscal year July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2024, on taxable property within the City Boundary subject to assessment and taxation under the provisions of the City Charter and Code and the laws of the State of Maryland.

NOW, THEREFORE:

SECTION I: BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FREDERICK, that the sum of Seventy-Three and 5/100 Cents (\$0.7305) on each and every One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) of assessable real property, and One Dollar and Fifty-Five Cents (\$1.55) on each and every One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) of assessable business personal property, be and the same are hereby imposed and levied for the fiscal year July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2024, on taxable property within the City Boundary subject to assessment and taxation under the provisions of the City Charter and Code and the laws of the State of Maryland.

SECTION II: BE IT FURTHER ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE AUTHORITY AFORESAID, that this Ordinance shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
